Cash awards will be by popular vote of those attending and awarded at the end of the show. Quilts may be any size, any theme. Quilts will be accepted at: Stitch, 243 W Broadway, Reardan, Washington or at Experience Quilts, 4 W 1st Ave., Odessa, Washington, on September 25 & 26 and Tuesday, September 29, 2020 from 10 am-4 pm. or in Spokane Valley by Calling Donna McMackin (509) 924-9781. A separate form is required for each entry. You will be issued a number and receipt when you drop off your quilt. You will need to present that receipt to pick up your quilt at the end of the show. All Quilts must be labeled with your name, address and phone number on the back, lower left of your quilt. Place each quilt in a clear or white plastic bag that does not need to be returned. You may pick up your quilt after the show on Sunday October 4th from 4:00-7:00 pm at the museum.
